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1. INTRODUCTION

It's clear that partners being cheated on in a relationship fall into three clear categories:

- Those that wouldn't even consider the possibility that their other half is playing around even when given good cause for suspicion.
- Those that suspect but would rather '*not know*' the truth as they cannot consider the ramifications were they to address the issue and get some bad news.
- Those that have a 'gut feeling' or suspicion and want to know for sure before confronting (or not) their partner with evidence of some sort of illicit affair or online shenanigans.

The **Cheatchatcher.com** site is only in a position to assist those in the last example – folks, possibly like yourself, who either suspect something untoward is going on behind their backs OR those that are 70% sure but require the final 30% of PROOF before confronting their partner or taking some other kind of action.

That friend would also have asked me to consider what my plan of action was going to be once I knew for sure something was going on e.g.

- Ask them to leave and start divorce proceedings?
- Leave and say that I 'might' come back at some future date if things returned to normal?
- Consider this an aberration on their part and be prepared to forgive and move on with our lives? In other words to calmly tell them I was aware of what was going on and ask them to stop the affair or risk losing our relationship.

2. CHEATING SIGNALS



Here's the thing: most cheaters can't help themselves giving off suspicious signals!

Sometimes because subconsciously they want to be caught or because in some perverse way they kind of want their partner to know – sounds weird right?

(and YES I know some of these have become clichés these days but that's because they really can give the game away!)

- **Physical Appearance**

Have they restyled, dyed their hair? Taken up a new gym membership? Started wearing 'trendier' clothes or simply developed a new bathing regime (e.g. having a shower as soon as they get home?) Buying fancy cologne?

- **How They Relate To You**

Has there been a deterioration in their 'respect' for you? Have they become more critical of your appearance, dress sense or similar? Do you feel that they are 'angry' with you most of the time when you are together?

- **Conversational Giveaways**

Is a certain work colleague or 'friends' name constantly coming up in (their) conversation?

- **Change In Work Habits**

They used to be home a 7 p.m. sharp every night but these days seem to have lots of evening work related sessions? Suddenly they have out of town work meetings, even on weekends?

- **Day-to-Day Behaviour**

Do you sometimes look at them, on weekends at home for example, and they seem to be 'somewhere else' and anxious? Are they constantly checking their cell phone for messages?

- **Joint Financial Affairs**

In the past their salary was paid into your joint account but now he/she has a separate account?

- **Travel**

Are they travelling out of town more than they used to?

- **Personality Changes**

Have you noticed 'changes' in the way they react to you and the family?

- **Absences**

Previously reliable, they'd always be where they said they would be, these days you sometimes find that you don't know where they are and can't contact them?

- **Telephone Behaviour**

Do they now leave the room to answer a cell phone call? Did they do that before?

- **Car Clues**

Ever noticed the feeling that somebody else has been in the car? A whiff of an unusual cologne or perfume?

- **Sex**

Have they wanted to try new sexual positions and techniques with you or expressed dissatisfaction with your love making? Has sex disappeared in your relationship or do you feel a distance on their part and that they are just 'going through the motions'?

- **Eating Habits**

Are they suddenly becoming more adventurous with the food they eat when you dine out? Have they suddenly developed a love for a particular style of cuisine that they never wanted before?

- **Smells**

Do they smell as if they've just showered when they come home? Or do they smell of perfume or make up?

- **Invasion of Your Home**

Have you recently found that spending weekends together has been replaced by inviting friends around often or being encouraged to go out with groups of people?

- **Gifts**

Do they sometimes bring you a gift for no apparent reason?

- **Computer Use**

Have they insisted that nobody access the home PC? Or go to a private room in the house when online? Do they only use their own laptop at home for checking email etc.

- **Cell Phones**

Do they automatically check for caller ID before answering their cell phone and go somewhere private to take the call? Are they texting when they never used to do so?

- **Physical Evidence**

It's not just lipstick on the collar or the smelling of a strange perfume on their clothes. Do they now lock the shower room door when bathing or turn off the light before undressing for bed? (I'm talking 'scratches' and the like here folks).

- **Behaviour Around the Opposite Sex**

Have they suddenly become more flirtatious with members of the opposite sex, waiters and waitresses for example? Do you sense a new 'confidence' in the way they talk to people?

WHEW! QUITE A LIST RIGHT?

But Let's Get One Thing Straight...

Even when one, two or more of those 'Cheating Signals' have made you sit up and say, "*Yes! That applies to my relationship.*" doesn't make it a no-brainer that you're the victim of a cheat!

For every suspicion and seemingly significant '*tell tale*' sign there is always another plausible explanation.

He's moved the computer to another room to go online in private?

Maybe he's just found a good soft porn movie or two or become a closet '*World of Warcraft*' online gamer. Maybe he's gambling at online casinos. You might not approve of any of that but it doesn't necessarily mean he's cheating on you – but that's your call, we all have different standards.

I COULD GO ON BUT I WON'T AS I'M SURE YOU'RE SMART ENOUGH TO SEE WHERE I'M GOING WITH THIS...

Suspicious, suggestions from 'well-meaning' friends and whatever else you have used as 'evidence' that your other half is cheating on you...

IT COUNTS FOR NOTHING!

Because it might mean many things, all circumstantial, until you prove something. How stupid are you going to look and how much damage will be done to your relationship if you jump to a conclusion without knowing the facts?

3. ONLINE SUSPICIONS & SOLUTIONS

But let's not be mistaken here, while seemingly innocent, emotional attachments can be made in online gaming too!

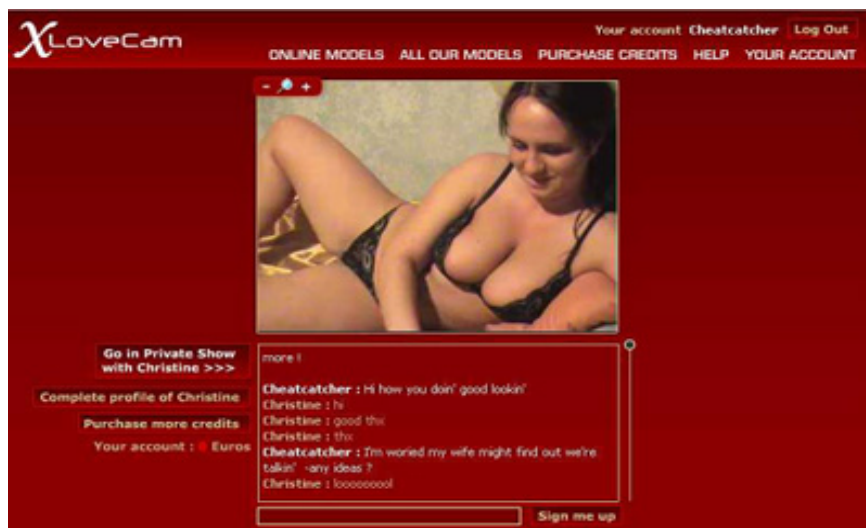
So any number of online activities, not necessarily related to being unfaithful – kind of depends on your definition of the term – can be a reason for their hiding what they are doing from you BUT by the same token can be a threat to your relationship too!

It's a kind of double standard I know! Are they doing it innocently or is there more to it?

For example they could be:

- Gambling online
- Participating in online forums
- Playing online interactive games
- Checking out their old school friends (and first loves!) via '**Friends Reunited**' or similar sites
- Communicating with past romances via **Facebook** etc.
- Creating a completely new cyber character in a massively popular site such as '**Second Life**' – people get married in there for chrissakes!
- Hanging out in **Chat Rooms** (nefarious or otherwise)

Or simply chatting to online sex workers via text, audio or video!



All I'm saying is that with an internet connection there is nothing anyone can't do and if you suspect your partner of doing this stuff, and you object to it, then you might consider my recommendations below.

Let's be clear here: It's never been easier for anybody to have, or arrange, sex online or a rendezvous for a real world assignation: AND IT'S CHEAP TO DO SO!

In today's economic climate the internet is full of extraordinarily gorgeous people happy to be paid for their time sexually – online or offline!

Saying that though 'online flirting' does not always result in real world affairs yet it has been recognized by leading psychologists that 'unreal' relationships of a sexual nature when online can lead to REAL issues in true real world relationships.

Issues such as forming online 'relationships' for money can give very false expectations for future meetings etc. and a LOT of money can change hands!

Many of you, I know, will consider sexual chat online with strangers or online professionals to be a form of betrayal and I can relate to that BUT yet again it always boils down to your own personal morals and those that you expect from your partner.

A partner caught out in this kind of activity might say that their doing this meant that they would never actively seek out a real physical affair and that this was simply an outlet by which they could titillate themselves – much like their admiring the photo shoots in a Playboy or Hustler magazine.

Once again that's your call not mine!

But to know what your partner is up to on the computer there are two solutions that I recommend:

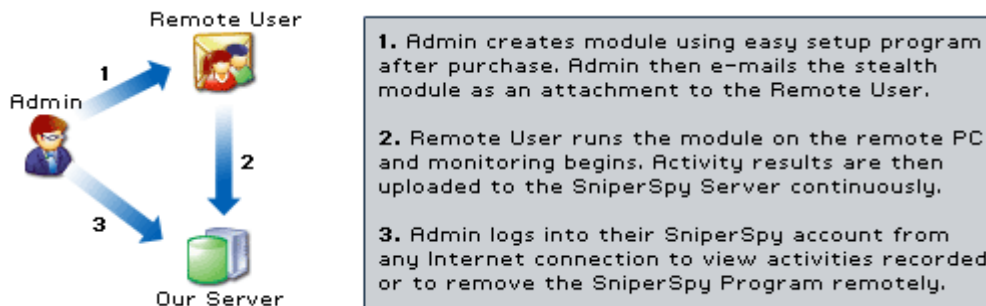

The Home version of this software is only \$39.95 and can be set up on your home PC or, say, your partner's laptop or work PC, and records everything they do online – sites visited, time spent, passwords (on dating sites for example) and records Instant Message chats

[Sniper Spy \(Click here\)](#)

More sophisticated than WinSpy this software allows you to watch, **in Real Time!**, what your partner is doing on their computer. Plus you have a downloadable record (as evidence) of sites visited plus loads more

In the small image below **admin=You**, **Remote=Target Computer** and **Server=SniperSpy server** – so you just login to your Sniper Spy account and watch what they are doing online be they out if town or in the next room!



4. Cell Phone Checking

There are a number of things you can do to catch somebody cheating via their cell phone.

A) For example let's say you have access to your partners cell phone records or his/her cell phone's address book. Suspicious about a number that he receives an unusual amount of calls from? Do a reverse telephone number check...

5. Car and other Tracking Ideas

Are they where they say they are? Working on the premise that they won't be too far away from their car (or suitcase) the why not harness the power of **GPS** (Global Positioning System)?

The cost of tracking devices has plummeted in recent years + they've got smaller too.

You could track in real time (via Google Earth for example) just like you see on TV or remove the tracking device on the suspect's return and see exactly where they've been. This can even be as detailed as to show how long the car remained stationary at any specific location (a motel car park perhaps?)

Most of these recorders are set to start monitoring via motion sensors to save recording space, others can be monitored by you from another location in real time – isn't technology wonderful!?

7. Background Checks

and a whole lot more, although this does depend on what country or US State you reside in.

Wow! Are you starting to see yet how Pro Active you can be?

8. Moving On (where do we go from here?)

OK listen!

Only you can decide what you are going to do about your suspicions.
